ELIGIBILITY

Free School Meals are available only to children whose parents/guardians are in receipt of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker’s Allowance
- Income-related Employment Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income, as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs, that does not exceed £16,190
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit

A further grant may be payable for year 9 and year 10. If your child attends a Hampshire secondary school you can obtain a form direct from the school office.

B) My child is in year 9/10 and I wish to be considered for a further Uniform Grant

Section D:- Declaration of parent/guardian
